FAIRHAVEN PARK STEWARDSHIP

Recreation Northwest is stewarding the Fairhaven Park trail system we have utilized for years for the Traverse by removing invasive species, rerouting trails to improve access and restoring wetland habitat through native plantings. In the fall of 2017, we completed a three year project to build a proper trail & wetland boardwalk connecting Fairhaven Park to the Chuckanut Community Forest.



The trail now bypasses the wetlands, allowing increased and enjoyable access for people as well as protecting this important habitat for wildlife and the ecology of the forest.

In addition, we planted 200 native trees and shrubs in the former trail bed to assist the recovery of this unique forest wetland.

Volunteers are needed each spring a fall to remove invasive species, plant new trees as shrubs and weed our new plants.
